Subject: Request for a U.S. Small Business Administration Physical Disaster Declaration – Kern and San Bernardino Counties

Dear Ms. Garfield:

The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) received a request for assistance as a result of the California Earthquakes that occurred July 5, 2019, in Kern and San Bernardino Counties. The M7.1 earthquake was preceded by a M6.4 foreshock and followed by over 14,000 aftershocks, resulting in structural damages to homes, businesses, and private non-profits.

A joint damage assessment was conducted by state and federal agencies on July 11-13 2019. The damage survey revealed more than 100 homes and/or businesses have uninsured losses of at least 40 percent of their value.

On behalf of Governor Newsom, I request you declare Kern and San Bernardino Counties a disaster area. A declaration by the SBA Administrator will provide low-interest, disaster loans for those adversely affected by the California Earthquakes.
