I am humbled and honored by your trust in me to represent California in the United States Senate. I look forward to continuing to serve the great State of California as a United States Senator and to ensuring that the rights and democratic principles we cherish are protected and preserved for all people.

I hereby resign from my position as California Secretary of State, effective Monday, January 18, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time.

In accordance with California Government Code section 1775, my Chief Deputy, James Schwab, shall discharge the duties of the office of Secretary of State until the vacancy is filled, as required by law.
