**A PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA
TERMINATING STATES OF EMERGENCY**


I, **GAVIN NEWSOM**, Governor of the State of California, having found pursuant to Government Code section 8629 that the conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property underlying the State of Emergency proclamations listed below no longer exist, therefore proclaim that the States of Emergency proclaimed on the following dates and in the following jurisdictions no longer exist, effective immediately. Accordingly, any Executive Order provisions related to the terminated states of emergency are no longer in effect.
