To the Members of the California State Assembly:

I am signing Assembly Bill 1901, which requires manufacturers of children's diapers to list all intentionally added ingredients on their website and requires packages of children's diapers to include a list of all intentionally added ingredients.

While I support the author's goal to increase transparency for parents purchasing diapers, this bill does not include the protections for confidential business information present in previous ingredient disclosure bills. An absence of flexibility around proprietary information could put manufacturers in a difficult position with their suppliers or lead to public disclosure of legitimate confidential business information. I encourage the Department of Toxic Substances Control to initiate its rulemaking authority under this bill to clarify these issues.
